





Description of the Design

As a person with special needs, we believe that all humans play their part in our community, even minorities. PWDs have their purpose in this life, based on their profession. Our purpose in this life does not run far from the others. PWDs, especially children and women, are still one of the main parts of shaping a country by law and part in shaping a country by law and by nature. Without one another, surely we can't truly function as a society. Like bamboo and the river bank, one can't function without the other. In our design, we use the RI logo as a symbol of "earth", which represents our society, using the background colour of reddish pink almost the same colour are used as an identification card for PWDs in Malaysia, a character who holds the RI logo upright, which indicates that PWDs plays a part in our earth, our society, our community. Characters are designed with different types of disabilities and skin colours, indicating that PWDs are diverse, and not only centered in one or two countries. Therefore, we must work together to serve, help, and grow with PWDs. We are one unit of the cell, without one another, we're just zero.




Description of the Design

1.Photo-1 (top-left): The YPAC ladies (members of the Executive Board) gathered around the table displaying products of handicrafts made by children with disabilities, whom from December 2022 have been attending regular vocational training classes (online and offline at the Creative House of YPAC Nasional located at the outskirt of Jakarta, South Tangerang City). The handicrafts (acrylic paintings on T-Shirt, eco-bags, cushion covers, table clothes, etc – besides the decoupage technique in turning used items into new ones by covering them with beautiful coated flowers motives of tissue papers), are on high demand now. YPAC Nasional is very proud as the children now can earn their own monies for their needs.

- 2.Photo-2 (top-right): A group of youths and chaperons in-front of a flour-produced building, completing a pastries making class. YPAC Nasional has facilitated these 24 special children, supported by relevant donors, with transportation cost, meals, as well as certificates for them to pursue a culinary startup. Many of them have directly practiced their skills by receiving orders from home for their pastries product and deliver them through the couriers.
- 3.Photo-3 (middle-left): The children performing a traditional dance in greeting the guests whom visited their school. The 20 YPAC Secretariats located in the 18 big cities in Indonesia, encouraging the youths to develop their talents as a way to enhance their confidence. Positive results have been made through the approach.
- 4.Photo-4 (middle-right): The offline training for youths with disabilities started to be provided again at the IT Training Centre of YPAC Nasional at the central Jakarta, early this year, after providing a few online trainings during the pandemic. Encouragement towards initiating a startup for the gained skills, such as becoming a Content Creator, Youtuber, etc, may be further added with a regular mentoring until they are successful.
- 5.Photo-5 (bottom-left): YPAC Nasional joined the Global IT Challenge in 2014, and since then, there are many Indonesian GITC winners. A proof that nothing is impossible, when you put your mind in developing/completing the given tasks based on your gained skills. Indonesia was awarded the highest awards as the Global IT Leader, twice: in 2015 through Dyan, a male youth with visual disabilities, and in 2018 through Fayza, a female youth with hearing impairment.
- 6.Photo-6 (bottom-right): A regular conference amongst the 20 YPAC Secretariats has been conducted every 3 years, to consolidate ideas as well as a platform for the new volunteers to catch-up with the existing programs. Usually attended by approximately 125 participants (members of the Board of Trustees, Board of Supervision, and Board of Executive), for a 3-night conference with Focus Group Discussions as well as receiving guidance from the seniors, and keynote speakers, such as The Indonesian Minister of National Education whom attended the recent conference in the city of Malang, East Java, in August 2022




